The Art Museum is a respected institution but it does not have the same passion or  
concern for veterans' issues that War Memorial officials have.

The repairs needed to be made at the War Memorial should be paid **with rent from the  
tenants** – including the Art Museum.

Returning veterans need services and programming – the War Memorial should increase its  
outreach and should not allow the Art Museum to decrease the emphasis on events and  
services for our current & future generations of Veterans.
