1943: Three-team, modified single-elimination.

1938: Ten-team single-elimination tournament with three pools divided by community size, leading to championship round.

1937: Nine-team single-elimination tournament with three pools divided by community size, leading to championship round.

1930-31, 1928: Best-of-three series vs. northern and southern champions.

1929: One-game championship vs. northern and southern champions.
